Lifting Lamb Survival is a practical, on-farm program delivered in a group training environment. This six-month program includes 3 workshops and an individual on-farm session, designed to support producers across the lambing season – from pre-lambing to post-marking.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

- Develop strategies to improve lamb survival and reduce ewe deaths.
- Implement best practice management for lambing success, including lambing density and ewe/lamb nutrition.
- Plan lambing paddocks, measure feed and allocate resources to optimise production.
- Undertake lamb autopsies to diagnose causes of lamb loss.

WHAT'S INVOLVED

Session 1: Setting up the lambing plan, 1 day (June 2024)

Session 2: Individual on-farm coaching to prepare your lambing plan, ½ day

Session 3: Fine tuning the lambing plan (includes lamb autopsy session), ½ day

Session 4: Reviewing the 2024 lambing season, ½ day
